The buzz of the dedicated Sixth Form Centre is one of the most exciting aspects of the School: 200 students, with different outlooks, interests and backgrounds.




In 2020, **93.8%** of all our A Level students achieved **A* - C** — our best results ever!

The **Young Enterprise Company** Programme provides our Sixth Formers with the opportunity to set up and run their own real company, whilst still at school. By taking part in the programme, students develop skills, knowledge and experience, which in turn has a proven long-term impact on their lives and careers.
